ENGLISH

We will be using the picture book 'The Arrival' to inspire character, setting and atmospheric descriptions. We will then be writing explanation texts and instructions based on our own inventions, similar to 'Wallace and Gromit's Cracking Contraptions'!

HISTORY

In History this half term, we will be learning about the Anglo Saxons & Vikings. We will be finding out about the Viking invasion, what everyday life was like at the time and how England became a unified country.

MATHS

In Maths this half term, we will be focusing on statistics (including calculating the mean average), as well as area and perimeter. We will also be working on shape and algebra. We will continue to recap and practise the key arithmetic skills.

COMPUTING

In Computing, we will be learning how to create and use spreadsheets on Microsoft Excel to collect and manage data.

SCIENCE

In Science, we will be learning about some of the great scientists and inventors such as Stephen Hawking, Alexander Flemming, and Mary Maynard.

PSHE

We will be discussing ways to look after our physical and mental health – with a focus on managing stress. We will also cover issues such as gangs and exploitation.
