English:

We will be learning all about wishing tales this half term.

We will be focusing on developing our character and setting description, as well as correctly punctuating speech.

Towards the end of this half term, we will create information texts on Victorian children, linking to our history topic.

French:

This half term we will be learning the vocabulary to do with shopping. We will learn the names of different shops and clothes in French. We will learn how to ask how much things cost.

Maths:

This half term we are focusing on fractions.

We will be learning how to add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions. We will also order, compare and simplify fractions.

We will then move on to geometry (position and direction) for the last two weeks of term.

Science:

Year 6 scientists will be studying electricity this half term. We will be carrying out lots of practical investigations using bulbs, batteries, wires, motors, buzzers and more!



Art:

This half term we will be experimenting with printing. We will be looking at print in different forms. We will be exploring the work of different artists such as William Morris.

PE:

On a Thursday this half term we will be doing gymnastics in the hall. On a Wednesday outdoors we will be doing tag rugby.

Please ensure your child has appropriate PE kit for both indoor and outdoor PE each week.

A reminder that hair must be tied back during PE lessons.

History:

During this half term, we will be studying the Victorians. We will be focusing our studies on the lives of children during this period. We will be using a variety of sources to help us learn.

RE:

In RE on a Friday with Mrs Napier, the children will be learning about Islam. They will be exploring the question:

How does <u>tawhid</u> create a sense of belonging to the Muslim community?

PSHE:

This half term in PSHE we will be celebrating diversity in many different ways. We will be learning about people with different special educational needs or disabilities; people from different faiths and cultures and refugees.

Music:

In Music lessons on a Friday with Mrs Napier, the children will be completing a Charanga unit called 'Happy' by Pharrell Williams. They will also be having a go at some music theory.

Computing:

This half term in Computing we will be learning all about staying safe online.
