

English:

We will be learning all about warning tales this half term.

We will be focusing on developing our setting description to build an atmosphere of impending danger.

We are also going to be doing a short persuasive writing unit as we didn't quite have time to squeeze this into last half term as originally planned!

Maths:

We will be starting this half term learning about decimals and percentages. We will be learning to multiply and divide decimals. We will be exploring fraction, decimal and percentage equivalences.

We will then move on to solving problems involving area, volume and perimeter.

Science:

Year 6 scientists will be studying light this half term. We will be carrying out lots of practical investigations exploring how light travels, how shadows are formed and how we see things.

French:

This half term we will be learning vocabulary to do food and drink.

We will focus on developing our speaking and listening skills.



DT:

In DT we will be working on a textiles topic. We will be carrying out research into cushions. We will be creating some cushion designs which meet various design specifications and then will have a go at making our own cushion covers using various sewing techniques.

PE:

On a Tuesday this half term we will be doing dance in the hall.

On a Wednesday outdoors we will be doing tag rugby.

Please ensure your child has appropriate PE kit for both indoor and outdoor PE each week.

A reminder that hair must be tied back and jewellery and watches must be removed during PE lessons.

Geography:

Our Geography topic this half term is Extreme Earth. We will be learning about climates around the world, extreme weather, natural disasters and survival in extreme conditions or situations.

RE:

In RE on a Friday with Mrs Napier, the children will be learning about Hinduism. They will be exploring the question:

How do questions about Brahman and atman influence the way a Hindu lives?

PSHE:

This half term in PSHE our topic is Dreams and Goals. We will be thinking about our future and learn about a variety of jobs and careers. We will then widen our thoughts to our world: how can we work with other people to help make the world a better place?

Music:

This half term our Charanga unit is 'How Does Music Improve our World?'. Within this unit, we will continue to develop our glockenspiel and singing skills through our study of two different songs.

Computing:

On Purple Mash with Mrs Napier, the class will be creating their own blogs based on their hobbies or interests. They will be creating these and then adding posts to them weekly. They will be sharing these with the class and giving one another feedback as they go, discussing ways they can improve them.
