Spring 2, 2022

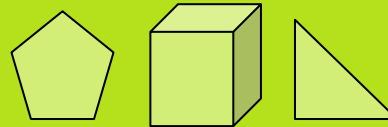
English

This half term we are writing Finding Tales, based on the model text 'The Tiger Who Came To Tea'. We will have a focus on conjunctions and punctuation. Later in the term, we will also be writing diary entries. Our current class novel is 'The Ghostly Galleon' by Jonny Duddle.



Maths

We will be learning about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, before moving on to measurement. We will also have a big focus on our arithmetic skills (the four operations and fractions of numbers) to prepare for SATs.



Science

Our topic for this half term is 'Living Things and their Habitats'. We will identify that most living things live in habitats or microhabitats to which they are suited. We will learn about simple food chains, which help us to understand how plants and animals depend on each other.



Geography

This half term we are learning about the UK. This will include naming continents, capital cities, landmarks, and surrounding seas.

Computing

We will be learning the basic skills needed to create and use databases. Some of this will be completed through 'Unplugged Computing' activities to promote logical thinking.

RE

Through the question "What are the best symbols of Jesus' death and resurrection at Easter?", we will be learning about the Easter story.

PE

This half term we will be practising our skills through target games and invasion games. *Please note that PE has moved to Thursday and Friday afternoons.

PSHE

We will be learning about how to keep ourselves healthy, including diet, exercise, and maintaining positive relationships.

Music

Our topic is "How Does Music Teach Us about Our Neighbourhood?"
